DAYTON CHRISTIAN SCHOOL ADMISSIONS POLICIES

Thank you for considering Dayton Christian for your child's education. Please read the following key admissions policies that are required to be met for application consideration. Refer to the admissions page of our website for the detailed admissions policies document.

- At least one custodial parent/legal guardian and the 7th-12th grade student are born-again Christians. (John 3:3, I Peter 1:23)
- At least one parent/legal guardian and the student are currently involved in and attend regularly a Bible-teaching church that agrees with the DCS Statement of Faith. (Hebrews 10:24-25)
- Parents/legal guardians will honor the sanctity of marriage as the legal union between one man and one woman (Genesis 2:23-24, Matthew 19:4-6) and will commit to upholding the biblical standards of moral purity (Romans 1:26-27,

which would also prohibit cohabitation. Based on this, a situation with unmarried adults living together is grounds for denying admission of an applicant and/or to discontinue enrollment of a student.

- The student has a sufficiently positive record of academic,* behavioral, and emotional preparedness to facilitate adjustment at DCS.
- The student has not been suspended or has been served an expulsion.
- The parents/legal guardians must demonstrate sound financial stewardship and responsibility.
- The parents/legal guardians and student understand that the school's guiding principle is to glorify God in all areas of the school and personal life, including on social media, and that our basis for instruction is the Bible.
- A partnership with parents in academics

*A GPA of at least a 2.0 is required for all middle and high school students
